TIMOTHY J. KRUEGER

Timothy J. Krueger studied musicology at the Wheaton Conservatory of Music, the University of Colorado, Boulder, the Universität Hamburg, Germany, and the University of London's Royal Holloway College, where his doctoral dissertation was on the sacred music of Charles Villiers Stanford. He has studied conducting with Dr. Paul Wiens, and privately with Dennis Keene of the Voices of Ascension. He has sung professionally with the Santa Fe Opera, the Santa Fe Desert Chorale, Chicago A Cappella, the Vox Early Music Ensemble, the Ars Nova Singers, as well as several Episcopal cathedral choirs. In addition to being the founding Artistic Director of St. Martin's Chamber Choir, Krueger has served as Chorus Director for the Boulder Bach Festival, the Colorado Music Festival, and the Boulder Philharmonic. He is an Affiliate Faculty member in the Music Department of Metropolitan State University of Denver. He is Choirmaster of St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, overseeing one of Denver's finest classical church music programs.



KABIN THOMAS

Kabin Thomas joined CPR Classical with decades of experience as a tuba player, actor and professor of classical music. For 11 years, he taught classical music to students at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville. During that time he was also the narrator and host of the Emmy Award-winning documentary, "The Sound of Dreams," about the Hot Springs Music Festival.

Kabin was a substitute tuba player with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra for 14 years. He and his wife currently perform a show called, "Peace, Love, and TubaStanding," which uses storytelling and music to tell a powerful story about love and courage amid tensions and fear.

Kabin served his country as an airman in the U.S. Marines (HML-776) and as a musician/sailor at the U.S. Naval Academy. Kabin studied acting and music at Oberlin College, as well as Wayne State University, and the Universities of Michigan and Wisconsin. Lastly, Kabin is a proud Friend of Bill since 2010, with his homegroup being Chandler Lodge in North Hollywood, CA.



SARA GARZA

Sara Garza (she/her) is a passionate conductor, educator, and vocalist who believes firmly in the necessity of equitable music education for all. Hailing from Lakewood, Colorado, Sara is currently pursuing her Master of Music degree in Choral Conducting at the University of Denver, where she is a Graduate Teaching Assistant for Voces Aureas and the Lamont Chorale. She received her Bachelor of Music Education degree from Metropolitan State University of Denver, where she studied voice with Gene Roberts and conducting with MB Krueger.

Prior to her graduate studies, Sara served as both the Vocal Music Director and the Spring Musical Director at Evergreen High School. She currently holds a position on the Colorado ACDA board, where she enjoys coordinating events and connecting with colleagues. Sara has performed with Elus Vocal Ensemble and the Colorado Symphony Chorus, as well as several collegiate ensembles and church choirs – she even enjoyed an undergraduate singer internship with St. Martin's Chamber Choir in 2018!

In 2022, Sara was honored to receive Evergreen Children Chorale's Arts Teacher of the Year award, given for her dedication to enrichment and inspiration of the arts in young people. She plans to return to the high school classroom after obtaining her Masters to continue in her passion for educating young musicians.

A NOTE FROM THE FOUNDER/ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

One of my passions as a choir director is uniting a concert with a story, either by way of sequencing pieces, such that a concert has a sort of narrative arc; or by following a theme itself. I love how this transforms a concert from a spectator activity to one where the audience becomes emotionally involved in the story being told.

That is why, a year-and-a-half ago, when I chanced upon the score of Benedict Sheehan's setting of music to go with a narration of Charles Dickens' *A Christmas Carol*, I immediately knew that I wanted to do it at one of our annual Christmas concerts. The choir in this work acts as the soundtrack (or the "Incidental Music," to use a more technical Classical term), undergirding and enhancing the drama with powerful, emotive music; and then, at key moments, breaking forth into the foreground with a beautiful arrangement of a carol that fits into the action, or comments upon it or informs it in some poignant way.

Now I will let the work speak for itself, and, on behalf of the staff, singers, and board of St. Martin's Chamber Choir, I wish you all the very happiest of holidays.
